Notes:-

- 1) Sem - Semester (June, October/November) / S Sem - Short Semester (March).
- 2) The **initial or advance payment of RM27,000 for Postgraduate programmes** (Doctor of Philosophy and Master Programme) shall be made after the student has fulfilled all admission requirements and has received official confirmation of acceptance to enroll at KLUST. This amount shall apply to students from the Global South and ASEAN countries, whereas an initial payment of RM30,000 shall apply to students from other countries.
Any shortfall or outstanding balance for Semesters 2 and 3 shall be settled in full on a semester basis. This payment arrangement shall likewise apply to each subsequent semester until the student has successfully completed the programme.
- 3) The total Semester fees are due upon registration. These fees are non-refundable, unless otherwise stated.
- 4) 60% of the Tuition Fee is refundable by submitting the "Withdrawal Form" within fourteen (14) days from the 1st day of Registration for each intake. 80% of the Tuition Fee will be refunded if the student withdraws before the 1st day of Registration. In both cases, the withdrawal must be approved by the Management.

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- 5) Tuition Fee is charged base on the number of standard credit hours registered for Master of Architecture, Master of Science in Water Resources, Master In Information Technology, Master in Communication, Master of Arts in Teaching English To Speakers of Other Languages (MA Tesol), Master of Business Administration (MBA) and MBA (ODL) according to each semester.
Other postgraduate programmes which are by research shall be charged base on semester basis and students are required to complete within the duration of study. However, if students are unable to complete their studies within this time frame, an additional tuition fee will be charged at the current semester rate for each extra semester, up to a maximum of eighteen (18) semesters for PhD Programmes, and eight (8) semesters for Master of Civil Engineering.
- 6) Students who do not fulfill the English language requirement are REQUIRED to enroll in the Intensive English Programme (IEP). A fee of RM4,000 will be imposed on students who fail to register for the IEP as required. This policy applies even to students who have not met the English proficiency requirement but have obtained English qualifications from external institutions or language centers. Students who arrive in Malaysia and obtain their visa under KLUST are also bound by this requirement.
- 7) Research students are required to pay an examination fee for a failed RPD — RM500 for Master's and RM750 for PhD students. Additionally, the Viva Voce examination fee is RM750 for Master's students and RM1,000 for PhD students.
Replacement of Student Card shall be charged at RM50 each.

- 9) Processing Fee is inclusive of i-Kad, Medical Insurance, Visa Processing and Medical Examination and is applicable to all international students. This fee is cover for 1 year and it is non-refundable. Processing Fee is chargeable once the completed application form is submitted to **KLUST**. For students who wishes to process his/her own visa directly to EMGS are required to make a processing fee of approximately of RM1,580 to **KLUST**. As for the **KLUST** progression students, the Processing Fee is RM2,500.
- 10) The renewal of i-Kad, Medical Insurance, Visa Processing and Medical Examination will be charged when it is due.
- 11) The Student Pass/Visa cancellation fee of RM100 is applicable when the student complete their studies or withdraw from **KLUST**.
- 12) Replacement of iKad due to damage or loss will be charged according to Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) rate.
- 13) International Student Administrative Fee is chargeable to all international students who arrive with e-VAL (Visa Approval Letter). The amount chargeable is RM8,000 for all postgraduate programmes.
- 14) Students are required to pay semester fees in FULL. However, they can opt for the Easy Payment Scheme (EPS) with a minimum payment of RM2,000 upon registration for a new semester with a condition of achieving minimum CGPA of 3.000. The balance of outstanding Sem/S Sem fees can be paid in a maximum of three (3) / two (2) equal monthly instalments. All fees must be fully settled two (2) weeks before the Final Examination.
- 15) Caution Fee may only be refunded by application after a student has completed or withdrawn from his/her programme of study. The application for the refund shall be made within 3 months from the date of completion or withdrawal from the university.
- 16) **KLUST** will refund the Caution fee only after the student completes the Deposit Claim form or Withdrawal form and it is refundable within sixty (60) days upon submission of respective forms to the Bursary Department. **KLUST** reserves the right to recover any outstanding amount owed by a student and will utilise the caution fee for partial or full settlement of any outstanding amount. (Please refer to Refund Policy)
- 17) All the settlement of fee must be in Ringgit Malaysia (RM) at the prevailing rate.
- 18) Effective 1 September 2025 : Private Education Services are subject to service tax 6% for non-Malaysian citizens in accordance with the Service Tax Regulations 2025.
